



SCURL Research Extra

Guide

The SCURL Research Extra scheme permits access and borrowing rights for academic staff and postgraduate research students of the Edinburgh College of Art Library (ECA) and the Royal Scottish Academy of Music and Drama Library (RSAMD) to SCURL HE libraries within Scotland. It also permits reciprocal access to ECA and RSAMD libraries under the same terms and conditions.

Procedures and conditions follow the terms of the SCONUL Research Extra scheme

- To register, users must be library members of good standing
- An application form can be obtained from the home library and a SCURL Research Extra card issued
- This must be taken along with your library/ID card to the library you wish to use where you will be issued with a library card with the same expiry date as that on the SCURL Research Extra card
- Users must abide by the rules and regulations of the library they wish to use and are responsible for any debts or charges they incur
- Borrowing limits and loan periods will be at the discretion of the host library.
- The host library may exclude certain categories of material available for reciprocal borrowing
- Users are encouraged to check the website (<http://scurl.ac.uk/about/access.html>) or contact the library in advance of visit to check opening hours etc
- Membership may be withdrawn if infringement of rules and regulations of library being visited occurs

IT facilities and access to networked/online resources are not included in this arrangement
